We are excited to be the host church for the Calvary Chapel Association Heartland Regional Pastors and Leaders Conference being held **on September 8th & 9th**. The conference will begin Friday afternoon and run through Saturday afternoon. Pastors and leaders from several Calvary Chapel churches across the Midwest will be attending. Conference speakers are Pastor Sandy Adams with Calvary Chapel Stone Mountain, Georgia, and Pastor Don McClure with Calvary Way, California.
