## GRIEFSHARE

Most churches do a wonderful job of caring for grieving people in the immediate days surrounding a death and funeral. Meals are provided, a service is conducted, and cards or flowers are sent. *But some grieverers need more.* A few days after the funeral, most of the people surrounding the griever return to their daily routines. The griever needs ongoing support and encouragement. That's the reason for **GriefShare**. GriefShare groups meet for 13 weeks, to help you face the challenges and move toward rebuilding your life. Each GriefShare session has 3 distinct elements:

1. DVD seminar with top experts on grief and recovery subjects.
2. Support group discussion about what was presented in the DVD, and what is going on in your life.
3. Personal study and reflection, where you will use your workbook to help sort out your emotions.

The group will use the workbook during sessions, asking questions and prompting discussion. Cost for the **REQUIRED** workbook is \$5 and payment is due at the first session. Pastor Dave will be facilitating the sessions starting Wednesday, **August 15<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 to 8:00pm**, at Grace. We will have room for 10 participants. Sign up is at the information desk, and contact Pastor Dave for more details.
